### Baptism



Did you know...water baptism is a symbolic burial by which followers of Jesus publicly declare they have died and are now beginning a new life in Christ. *Baptize* is the English form of a Greek word which means to immerse: to place something into something else.

In Christian water baptism, the believer is put completely under water, then immediately raised out of the water. Water baptism is a statement of faith: my old life is behind me, I am a new person, with a new life.

Water baptism is a sign of repentance - repentance means change - a change so drastic that the old person is "buried." It does not make you acceptable to God. As a work of righteousness, trying to obtain a good standing with God, it is worthless. Water baptism is a way of giving testimony to what has happened inwardly and a clear commitment to turn from your old life.
